## Huge lag highlights Houston Open

HOUSTON, Texas — A match-ending 4-lag in a championship match and the continued dominance of open singles by one of the shuffleboard's most consistent performers highlighted the 2004 Houston Open the last week of December at the Sheraton Brook Holiday Inn.

Witnesses said Mickey Moy's 4 in the championship game of the Division II Bring partner event was so deep that seemed to defy gravity as she and partner Lorraine Olson topped Dave Ramold-Bob Lee.

Oklahoma's Bill Melton collected his second straight major singles victory when he topped Kelly Cameron in the finals of the Pro Singles. Melton also won the event in the North American Shuffleboard Championship in Reno in November.

Washington's Jim Tribble had a strong tournament with a pair of championship finishes. He teamed with Billy Mays to win the A/B Draw Partner, Division I and took the Division I singles.

Mickey Moy also was in on winning two events, the doubles victory with Olson and was on a 4-person team, add to 1 that won that event. Joining her on the four-person team were Mike Taylor-Jim Payne and Kelly Cameron.

Tournament officials report 180 players competed in the tournament, down a little from last year because of inclement weather conditions across the country and the state of the economy.

Sixty-four players made their first appearance in the tournament. Many 3s and 4s were competing in their first-ever tournament, organizers said.

*Canadian Legion plans Easter events*

VICTORIA, British Columbia — The 7th Annual Canadian Open Short Board Shuffleboard Tournament is scheduled Easter weekend (March 24-27) at the Esquimalt Legion #172.

The tournament includes mixed doubles, doubles and singles in three divisions determined by Bowers rating or by the number of times a player has qualified for the Canadian shuffleboard Championships from 1995-2004.

The mixed doubles will begin at 11 a.m. Friday, March 25 with the doubles at 11 a.m. Saturday, March 26 and the singles at 11 a.m. Sunday, March 27.

In addition there is an ABC event at 6 p.m. on Thursday, March 24. There is a \$20 entry fee and no calculutta for this event that will finish the same night.

Players will pay entry fees based on which division they are assigned. Bowers players rated up to 1.49 will pay \$35 and play in division A. Players ranked between 1.50-3.49 will play in division B and pay \$25 per event while players above 3.5 will pay \$15 for each division C event they enter.

Canadians who have qualified for the Canadian Shuffleboard Championships three or more times will pay \$35 per event; 1 or 2

times, \$25 per event and players who have never qualified will be charged \$15 per event.

Organizer George Prior expects to have 10 boards in place for this tournament.

There are some rules that American players aren't used to. First of all, Canadian Congress Shuffleboard rules apply. Players can only use Canadian shuffleboard weights and there will be no practicing on the boards prior to games.

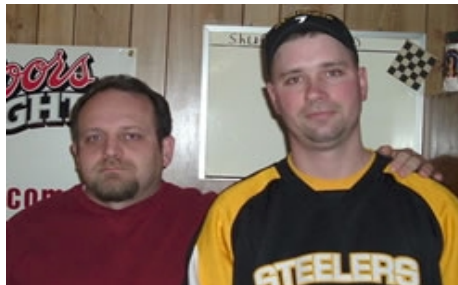
## Anglin-Collins win in Indiana storm

In his story about the tournament, assistant director James Cummings wrote: "A tournament of this size takes a lot of hard work. Fortunately we have a great staff and volunteers that make this tournament possible. The 27 boards were unloaded and assembled December 23rd. Unloading, placing, assembling and adjusting 30 boards is no minor task. Did you know that each board consists of 4 legs, 8 adjustable feet, 2 cradle halves, center section / scoreboard and the 500# board itself as well as 16 bolts nuts and washers and power cords for assembly?"

"We have a crew of 4 that helped run the desk taking care of registrations, entries, sponsor sales and payouts. Two auctioneers ran the sales with help from several spotters. Four people helped run the bracket boards during the week. Two ran our pari-mutuel sales. Every morning we had a man cleaning and vacuuming the boards and another preparing the wax and putting it out on all the tables. During the evenings we had 4 waitresses, working for tips only, serving the players. This is no small task with the players

constantly moving from board to board. After the tournament and the party, 14 volunteers disassembled the boards and loaded them onto the trucks. Without the staff and volunteers the Holiday Open could not operate."

Jack Scott was tournament director, assisted by Cummings and Bill Rice.
