Ratings that are fair for everyone

Recently I was reading a story in “The Hammer,” which is the monthly publication sent to members of the Missouri Shuffleboard Players Association.

The article made me think that the author wasn’t alone in her plight.

“My destiny, I fear is to be forever a bridesmaid,” the woman wrote.

During the 2004 Missouri State Championship, the writer had finished fourth in the singles, not even good enough to win a plaque.

When the 2005 Bowers’ rating came out this woman found she’d been rated 2.38, down considerably from the 2.54 rating she had in 2004. That also means she’ll have to move to higher level of competition in the 2005 Missouri State Tournament . . . if she competes at all.

None of the three people who finished ahead of this woman in this state tournament were moved a higher level of competition for the next state tournament.

“I played my heart out at the State Championship. And I played well. I was at the top of my game. The point isn’t to

toot my own own horn but to state that I was at the *TOP* of my game, and my best play netted me a bridesmaid position in Division II.”

I have been a proponent of a performance-based rating system for a long time and this Missouri woman’s situation points out the problems with the system currently in place. A popular-vote style of ratings can leave players looking for the door when they feel they have no chance to compete.

A performance-based rating system would keep this woman and many other players competing at levels where they will remain interested while their skill levels improve to a place where they could be an A or high B and still have chance to compete.

The current rating system could be one of the reason tournament attendance declines.

Her words:

“I realize that I’m not the only person with this dilemma. I’m sure there are those of you who can relate no matter what division you’re classed in. And I also have a choice to make with respect to the 2005 Missouri State Championship. I can choose to opt out this year, knowing that my money will be simply donated into someone else’s pocket. Or I can choose to look at this as an experience to “up” my level of play and perhaps work my way towards another bridesmaid position in Division I.”
