SHELTON, Wash. -- On April 18th, 1995 the Northwest premiere shuffleboard tavern changed ownership and philosophy; shuffleboard was out and dancing was in. Two months later the Forest Festival Tournament, which was previously scheduled, took place and so did another change in philosophy. This first tournament for the new owners was a huge success and cemented shuffleboard tournaments in the minds of the owners. Nine years have past since that first tournament and the Fir Cone is still one of the best places to play, and the Forest Festival is one of the most fun tournaments at the Fir Cone.

This year marks the 16th year that the Forest Festival Tournament has been going on, and the fifth year that it has been an A-B format. Past winners of the "A-B" Forest Festival Tournament are:

The tournament has to finish in two days, but if you go to far on the first day you run the risk of physically and mentally exhausting the

Jack Steffensen Memorial & HOF induction

TACOMA, Wash. — Longtime player Jack Steffensen will be inducted into the Pacific Northwest Shuffleboard Hall of Fame during a tournament bearing his name Sept. 24-26 at the Nifty Fifty's III, 13021 Pacific Avenue in Tacoma.

Steffensen died nearly two years ago.

The induction ceremony will take place at 4 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 25.

Steffensen was an avid league player — sometimes competing in as many as three different leagues at the same time.

He is recalled as a strong weight player who is recalled as “really blasting weights.”

Steffensen was a promoter of the game and helped many young players to get started. His appreciation of the game helped keep shuffleboard alive in an around Tacoma for many years.

Tournament play opens on Friday, Sept. 24 with an Open Draw at 7 p.m. The entry is \$10 per person.

There will be two tournaments running simultaneously on Saturday and Sunday, Sept. 25-26.

The Division I Doubles is open to all players, but two -1s may not play together, and has an entry fee of \$50 per player.

Division II Doubles is for players rated 1.50 in the Bowers System. The entry fee is \$25 per player.

Both divisions will be 2 out of 3 in the winners' bracket with one game to 21 points in the losers' bracket. The famous Nifty Fifty's

coast. P.S. as a spectator, it was exciting to watch Gary George and Tim Nugent take first place on his 50th birthday at the Grand Masters in Quilicene. Who says this isn't a spectator's game!

Hobbies outside shuffleboard: Loving my mother, wife, daughters, grandchildren

If you could do one thing to improve shuffleboard what would it be: I don't know what it might be unless we could get more B-C players to go play at other bars to get their feet wet.

NW Hall of Fame names 4; changes selection process

QUILCENE, Wash. — The Pacific Northwest Shuffleboard Hall of Fame underwent a number of changes and selected four players for induction during a recent meeting here.

Two of the four aren't named yet because of surprise induction plans. The named are Don "Mitch" Mitchell, Washington, and Jack Steffensen of Washington.

Mitchell is scheduled to be inducted during ceremonies at the Grand Masters Tournament in Quilcene on July 31.

Steffensen will be honored posthumously on Saturday, Sept. 25.

No date has been set for Fisher's induction ceremony but it could come during the Rural American Championships at his 99 Tavern and Willee's Cafe in Winston, Ore. Sept. 2-6.

Frank Mako, who founded the Pacific Northwest Shuffleboard Hall of Fame several years ago, recruited a committee to formalize and ease the selection process.

Under the new procedure, nominating a person to the Hall of Fame can be done by notifying Mako at 360-769-7132. There will be no need to circulate a petition in order to nominate someone.

Currently the committee consists of Mako, Paulette McKinney, Mike Waters, Bill Walker and Jim Manders. Committee members, during the recent meeting, voted to have two representatives each from British Columbia, Oregon and Washington with the president's position being at-large in order to better represent the entire area.

People from Oregon and British Columbia wishing to serve on the committee should contact Mako.
