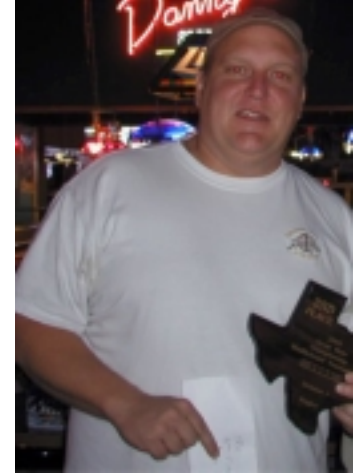

## Darroll's number 1 ranking slipping?

Again Oregon's Darroll Nelson is the top-rated shuffleboard player according to the Bowers Ratings, but his number one spot appears to be threatened.

Nelson received a -1.25 rating to lead 58 others who were given the -1 rating.

But right behind him was Oklahoma's Bill Melton at -1.23.

Melton may be pushing for the number one spot having one the Open Singles in the North American Shuffleboard Championships

in Reno, the Houston Open the week after Christmas and the President's Day Tournament at Ripon, Calif. in February.

Bobby Voorhis of Indiana is third at -1.19 while Billy Melton, Jr., of Texas, is fourth at -1.16. Diana Hagen, Texas, is the worlds' highest rated woman with a -1.11 rating to round out the top five.

The two Californias and Washington each had eight -1s to lead the state competition.

# Three are 'average' in Bowers' ratings

Are there any players who are average?

Yup. A search of the records showed Denny Adams and Barb Wilson of Michigan as well as Goose Gosling of Texas holding the average rating.

We found a picture of Gosling on the Bowers Shuffleboard Corner website but Wilson and Adams weren't there and apparently they don't get Lagging4s.

Canada isn't a state and wasn't divided into provinces. Its 269 players had an average rating of 3.35 and didn't have anyone rated under 1.

Indiana's 1.31 was the best average in geographical areas of more than 100 players. Southern California was second with 1.48 and Washington, with 241 players came in a with a 1.67 average for second.

Nebraska, with 279 players, easily had the highest per player average at 2.73. Dallas Fort Worth was second at 2.52 and Missouri was third 2.49.

Oh, by the way, Lagging4s editor/publisher Jim Manders, who has often been critical of the rating system received a .61 rating, up from .59 in 2004.

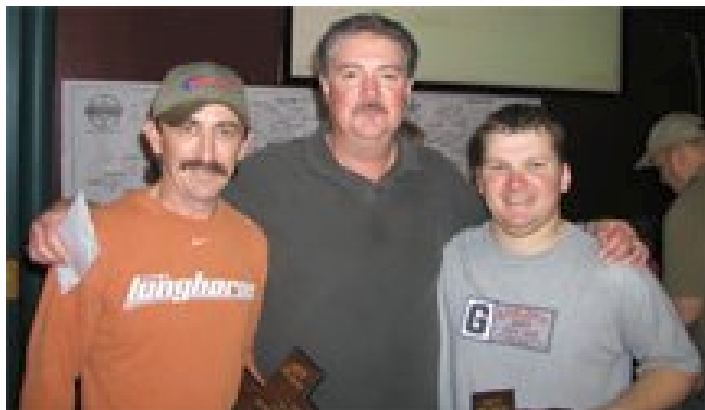
