SoCal amateur champs

HUNTINGTON BEACH, Cal. - The field of players was not quite what was expected, but the inaugural California State Amateur Championships went off without a hitch this past weekend at the Huntington Beach Moose Lodge with two teams taking home championship hardware in the tournament's two separate events. The event was sponsored by Long Beach based Jammin' Foods, who contributed \$100 of added money into each tournament.

Nine teams were on hand to compete in the "Add-to-Five" Doubles with four teams signed in for the "Add-to-Three" event. The Friday night sponsor sale was run by Paramount's Paul Weber with the team of Escondido's Kenny Hawkes and

'Peas' could ease lack of information

In James Cummings' letter to the editor he writes, "BUT!! What would keep it from working is shuffleboard players are an inherently lazy group. Keeping a performance based rating system requires a lot of work and effort by a lot of local players..."

Shuffleboard players are inherently lazy? I did not know that. Does the golf rating (handicap) system exist because golfers aren't lazy? I don't think so. It works because the golfer isn't asked to do any additional work; simply drop your scorecard into a box.

Regardless, the important thing is we agree that the hurdle to result-based ratings is gathering the information. The "answer" is to come up with a way that allows a tournament director to submit results in a way that is no more taxing or complicated than dropping a golf scorecard in a box. The software I've been developing, "Computer Peas", is an attempt to remedy this problem. By computerizing the charts, submitting tournament results can be accomplished by simply connecting to the internet and hitting a "Submit" button.

So instead of trying to persuade tournament directors to assemble their results, and do a bunch of data entry, the emphasis shifts to trying to convince them to do the charts on a computer rather than on the wall. This is somewhat of an uphill battle, but a battle that can be won. With each new person that is bold enough to use the software in their tournament, another believer is born.

At the risk of turning this into an ad for Computer Peas I won't go into the details of how much time and aggravation the software will save you during the tournament. The point here is to discuss practical ways to accomplish the task of gathering tournament results. My point is to focus on ways to make the process simple (almost invisible) to the people responsible for submitting results, and not to try to persuade them to do more work than they are already doing. I have found that people who run shuffleboard tournaments are anything but lazy.

Shuffleboard a big draw in Shanghai

SHUFFLEBOARD, a game familiar to many Westerners but new to most Chinese, has arrived in Shanghai. The Lilac Bar in the Xinhua Hotel on Huashan Lu was among the first to introduce the new recreational activity to the city.

Hu Jiahui, manager of the Lilac Bar at Xinhua Hotel and Zhu Xiaojie, hotel executive, share a moment with the shuffleboard.

Despite the high cost of over 30,000 yuan (\$3,614) for one set of facility, the hotel did not hesitate to buy four sets, especially after seeing the rapid popularity that shuffleboard has gained over the last year in Beijing.

Composed of a long table with smooth sand spread on its surface and pucks wrapped with metal, shuffleboard bears a certain resemblance to bowling except that what awaits the pucks in the end are not pins but four lines marked with varying points.

"The sand spread on the table is made of fine corn and silicone wax," said Zhu Xiaojie, supervisor of the hotel's recreational department.

"By spreading a layer of sand, the surface of the board becomes especially smooth, which adds a lot of difficulty to the shooting of pucks."

Road to fame

The shuffleboard, first called shoveboard and then, inexplicably, shovelboard, appears to have originated in England, where there is a record of it being played in 1532.

In its earliest form it consisted of shoving coins across a polished tabletop as a pastime for royalty, but later the game became so popular with the masses that people stopped going to work, causing it to be banned.

Shuffleboard first came to the United States and enjoyed tre-

mendous growth during the late 1800s and early 1900s. The great hotels in Atlantic City had five or six tables each.

Then came prohibition. Speakeasys didn't want games of skill. They had been assured of all they needed to be successful in their businesses by the US Congress.

It was during this eight- to 10-year period that shuffleboard began to decline.

Following the repeal of Prohibition, shuffleboard players began to reappear, largely on the East Coast.

The game hit its greatest height of popularity in the 1950s. Most major shuffleboard manufacturers sponsored nationwide shuffleboard tournaments. These were the biggest tournaments ever held; one tournament had 576 teams participating.

Rules

The game is played between two people or two teams. Initial shooting and the colour of the pucks are decided by a coin flip.

Players continue to alternate shooting until all pucks are used. Points are counted after each shooting.

The puck scores one point if it stops between line 1 and line 2.

There are four lines at the other end of the board. If the player can push the puck across the last line, he will score 4 points. Of course, the puck shouldn't be shot outside the board.

If one can shoot the puck so exactly that he makes it hang over the end of the board (not the side), it is called a "hanger" and can count for five points.

Richard Li, after playing several times here with his friends, is now a master of the game.

"When you are shooting the pucks, don't just use your fingers," Li pointed out. "The wrist and the shoulder should harmonize with

Santa Clara's Lorraine Olson going as the high bid team in the "Add-to-Three" event. Manteca's Eddie Brayman and Santa Clara's Jason Bingham were the high Calcutta in the "Add-to-Five" tournament.

Play began Saturday morning with the "Add-to-Three" teams involved in a true round robin - meaning each team would play against the other three teams. At the end of the day Hawkes and Olson along with the team of Orange's Jerry Harp and Long Beach's Gary Jones were tied with identical 2-1 records forcing a one-match playoff to decide the championship. The finals ended quickly with Harp and Jones winning the very close first game 15-14 and the next 15-10 with Jones lagging a one to make it two straight and win the state amateur doubles championship.

The "Add-to-Five" event also began on Saturday morning with Brayman and Bingham and the team of Bellflower's Mina Bischara and Whittier's Sandy Flood winning their early games. Both undefeated teams faced each other in the winner's bracket with Brayman and Noel taking the win that gave them some down time as they waited for an opponent to come from the loser's side. Meanwhile the team of Modesto's J.R. Noel and Livermore's Brent McQuillan had worked their way through the loser's bracket, following an early loss to Brayman and Bingham, and faced off against Bischara and Flood with the winner to advance to the championship. Bischara and Flood came up short and Noel and McQuillan again faced Brayman and Bingham for the tournament title. In the all Northern California championship it was all Brayman and Bingham as they won two straight games to win.

The "Add-to-Five" tournament paid out \$550 in entry money and \$1,100 in the sponsor pool. Lorraine Olson and Kenny Hawkes sponsored the winning team of Brayman and Bingham. The "Add-to-Three" event paid \$500 in entry fees and another \$660 in sponsor pool money. Huntington Beach's Richard Warren was the winning sponsor of the Jones and Harp team. Both events used the 2004 Bower's Ratings System.

Richard Warren and Robert Davidson served as tournament directors. Many thanks are extended to Marie Coulter and the officers and members of the Huntington Moose Lodge and their ladies auxiliary for their tireless efforts in making the small but well-run tournament a success. Also thanks goes out to the tournament's sponsor James Mitchell and Jammin' Foods LLC.

the fingers when shooting."

A knack Li wants to impart to beginners is never to shoot too well in the first two rounds, as your rival can easily push the pucks outside.

"It is enough just to shoot your first two pucks at the one point area, as your opponent may by mistake push your pucks to those high point areas with his pucks," Li said.

It is not chance that decides the winner, but skill.

Hu Jiahui, manager of the bar, believes that the intrinsic appeal of the game - the skill, diversity and competitiveness - will soon win popularity with local people.
