Billy Chiles Memorial at Huntington Beach

HUNTINGTON BEACH, Calif. – The Huntington Beach Moose Lodge 1832 will again host the annual Billy Chiles Memorial tournament this Labor Day weekend at its spacious Southern California facilities in the beach community known as “Surf City” This year’s edition will feature another event, as tournament organizers have added an “Add-to-Four” Doubles event to the shuffleboard tournament’s format. The new doubles event is becoming very popular with shuffleboard players in the Southern California area.

The Chiles’ Memorial opens with the traditional ABC Draw on Friday, Sept. 3. The sponsor sale is set for 8 p.m. Both the “Add-to-Four” Bring Partner Doubles and the “Add-to-Two” Bring Partner Doubles sponsor sale are scheduled for Saturday afternoon, Sept.. Play in both doubles event is scheduled to begin that evening. The 2004 Bowers System Ratings will be used for all events.

Richard Warren and Marie Coulter will again serve as tournament directors with Warren and Yorba Linda’s Bob Brunskill handling the tournament bracketing and Paramount’s Paul Weber handling each event’s team auctions.

The ABC Draw and the Add-to-Four Doubles entry fee per player is \$25 and the “Add-to-Two” Doubles requires a \$50 entry fee per player. The tournament’s directors guarantee a 100 percent payout from the entry fee and sponsor pools. There is a one-time registration fee of \$20. Six boards will be available for tournament play with a best of two out of three format set for both winner’s and loser’s brackets in all three events. Times and formats are subject to change however, due to player participation.

Last year’s classic attracted a record 81 players and paid out almost \$16,000 to the top teams involved in both events. Temecula’s Jimmy Martin and San Mateo’s Jane Mourgos won the doubles while the team of Phil Fridley of Las Vegas, Yorba Linda’s Anna Brunskill and Arizona’s George Gray won the ABC Draw tournament. The Billy Chile’s tournament was supported last year by large groups of players from the Las Vegas, Phoenix and Central California areas. They are expected back again this year.

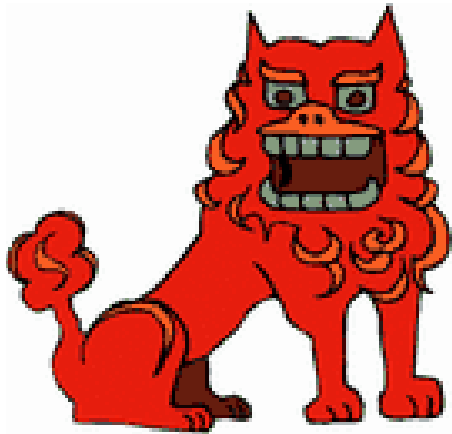

More pictures were taken and shirts were exchanged and they went on their way.
